



## **Situational Report for Typhoon KIKO(2021)**

### **SitRep No. 7 for Typhoon KIKO (2021)**

**September 17, 2021 08:00 am**

07 September 2021

- 11:00 PM: "KIKO" entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility and intensifies into a typhoon.

08 September 2021

- 5:00 AM: Typhoon "KIKO" undergone a period of rapid intensification over the Philippine Sea.
- 5:00 PM: Typhoon "KIKO" further intensified and continued to move West Southwest over the Philippine Sea.

09 September 2021

- 5:00 AM: Typhoon "KIKO" resumed its intensification over the Philippine Sea East of Central Luzon.
- 5:00 PM: Typhoon "KIKO" moved West Northwestward over the Philippine Sea East of Aurora.

10 September 2021

- 2:00 AM: Typhoon "KIKO" continued to move West Northwestwards towards Extreme Northern Luzon.
- 5:00 AM: It slightly weakened over the Philippine Sea East of Southern Isabela.
- 8:00 AM: It maintained its strength as it threatens extreme Northern Luzon.
- 11:00 AM: Typhoon slightly intensified as it threatens extreme Northern Luzon.
- 2:00 PM: It moved northwestward as it threatens extreme Northern Luzon.
- 5:00 PM: "KIKO" intensified further as it endangers extreme Northern Luzon.
- 8:00 PM: It maintained its strength as it moves over the waters off Northeast of Sta. Ana, Cagayan.
- 11:00 PM: It maintained its strength and headed towards Babuyan Islands.

11 September 2021

- 2:00 AM: Typhoon "KIKO" was about to make landfall or pass very close to Babuyan Island.
- 5:00 AM: "KIKO" had passed to the east of Babuyan Island and is now heading towards Batanes.
- 8:00 AM: It was about to make landfall in the vicinity of Batan and Sabtang Islands in Batanes.
- 11:00 AM: "KIKO" slightly weakened and had moved over the coastal waters of Itbayat, Batanes
- 2:00 PM: It weakened further as it continues to move over coastal waters of Itbayat, Batanes
- 5:00 PM: It continued to weaken while moving over the coaster waters of Itbayat, Batanes.
- 8:00 PM: It had moved North Northeastward over the Bashi Channel.
- 11:00 PM: Typhoon "Kiko" was over the sea east of Taiwan.

12 September 2021

- 2:00 AM: Typhoon "Kiko" moved northward over the sea east of Taiwan.
- 5:00 AM: It slightly weakened and is now over the sea east of central Taiwan.
- 11:00 AM: It maintained its strength while moving over the sea east of northern Taiwan.
- 5:00 PM: "KIKO" slightly weakened and exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility.
